**Introduction**

Please be advised that the County of Sacramento Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and approved a Report of Disposal Site Information (RDSI) Amendment to the Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) for L and D Landfill. The LEA is certified by the California Integrated Waste Management Board to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities within the County and City of Sacramento.

**Description of project and LEA's determination**

L and D Landfill is a 251 acre site in the City of Sacramento and is operated by L and D Landfill, LP and owned by Fruitridge Road Land Company. L and D Landfill is designed to assist the County of Sacramento and other jurisdictions in complying with local waste reduction and recycling goals and ordinances. L and D Landfill accepts residential and commercial refuse. This facility is located at 8635 Fruitridge Road, Sacramento, CA 95826. On September 8, 2008 the LEA received from L and D Landfill, a SWFP application package to amend the RDSI requesting to revise the document to:

- Add equipment and personnel for automation of C&D Recycling
- Enlarge the recycling pad
- Expand access roads to the recycling pad

No other change to the SWFP is under consideration at this time. The LEA finds that the proposed changes are consistent with the California Integrated Waste Management Board State Minimum Standards, and is consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documents. The proposed changes do not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current Solid Waste Facilities Permit. The LEA approved the amendment on October 7, 2008.
