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## **Introduction**

Please be advised that the County of Sacramento Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and approved a Registration Tier Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) for Sierra Waste Wood Grinding Company (Sierra Waste). The LEA is certified by the California Integrated Waste Management Board to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities within the County and City of Sacramento.

**Description of project and LEA's determination**

Sierra Waste is located on a 4.75 acre site in the City of Sacramento and is operated by Sunil Dutt and owned by Chander and Bal Soan and Sunil Dutt. Sierra Waste is designed to assist the County of Sacramento and other jurisdictions in complying with local waste reduction and recycling goals and ordinances. Sierra Waste accepts green material, including untreated wood wastes and construction and demolition wood waste. This facility is located at 8260 Berry Avenue, Sacramento, CA 95828. On September 10, 2009 the LEA received from Sierra Waste Wood Grinding Company, an application for a Registration Tier Solid Waste Facility Permit. The Registration Tier SWFP will allow Sierra Waste to conduct the following Chipping and Grinding Operation under the Compostable Materials Handling Regulations (Title 14 CCR):

- Receive between 200 and up to 500 tons per day of green material from the public
- All material will be processed within 48 hours of receipt
- Processed material will be used for bio-fuel at power plant companies.

The LEA finds that the proposed project is consistent with the California Integrated Waste Management Board State Minimum Standards, and is consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documents. The proposed changes do not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current Solid Waste Facilities Permit. The LEA approved the Registration SWFP application on September 29, 2009. The Registration Tier Permit will replace Sierra Waste's current EA Notification.
